The Perceive, Recall, Plan & Perform Intervention is designed for use by occupational therapists who have completed a PRPP Assessment course. The intervention approach aims to improve task performance mastery by addressing the specific cognitive strategy application behaviours identified through PRPP assessment as most impacting on mastery. Instructional methods used to address these behaviours incorporate cues and prompts that align with specific perceive, recall, plan and perform processing operations and preferences. The efficacy of this approach has been observed in children and adults with a variety of diagnoses and conditions that impact on everyday cognition, and demonstrated through research with adults with traumatic brain impairment and children with social and behavioural difficulties.

Car parking charges are from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday. Please plan for an £8 parking charge for the Friday, Monday and Tuesday. Car parking is free outside working hours or weekends, and so Saturday & Sunday will not be subject to the charges.

From the A1 North- Exit A1 at Gosforth A167 turn off and follow the A167 towards the City Centre. Remain on A167 / A167(M) for approximately 1 miles, then bear left onto the A1058 for Tynemouth / East. Continue on A1058 for about 2 miles (straight on through Jesmond and past Corner House pub). Exit left onto the slip road signposted for Walker / Walkergate Hospital / Benfield Road. The Centre is about 0.5 mile along Benfield Road on the right; opposite Benfield School.

A1(M) from the South - Just past Washington Services, exit the slip road right onto A194(M) and follow signs for the Tyne Tunnel. Proceed through the Tunnel (toll fee for cars). At roundabout immediately after the tunnel exit, head north on the A19 signposted for Morpeth. After 1 mile, take the first exit left at the roundabout, signposted for A1058 to Newcastle. After 2.5 miles pass under a railway bridge and exit left onto the slip road signposted for Walker / Walkergate Hospital. At top of slip road turn left onto Benfield Road. the Centre is about 0.5 mile along Benfield Road on the right; opposite Benfield School.

By Bus –The No. 1 is a frequent service and runs every 7 – 8 minutes Monday to Friday. The service stops on Debdon Gardens/Rothbury Terrace by its junction with Benfield Road (approximately 300 metres from Walkergate Park).

No. 1/2 Four buses per hour run during the day and two per hour run during evenings and Sundays. The 1 and 2 are fully wheelchair accessible. These services both stop at junction of Appletree Gardens and Benfield Road (approximately 350 metres from Walkergate Park).

No. 3 Three morning and two afternoon journeys only. This bus stops just outside Walkergate Park. More information on bus timetables is available from Nexus who can be contacted as follows:

By Metro The Centre is a short walk from Walkergate Metro station. Turn left out of the station and proceed along Benfield Road. The Centre is past Walkergate Medical Centre on the left hand side directly opposite Benfield School.
